Videos can be of you doing poetry, giving a vlog, shooting places that are important to you with a voiceover, doing a make-up tutorial, rapping to your own lyrics, performing an oli (Hawaiian chant), or almost anything else ... as long as it shows us who you are! Send us a link to your video through YouTube or Vimeo (ask your parents/guardians for permission first). We highly recommend that you post your video with the setting on PRIVATE.
