COVID-19 Camper Guidelines

Guidelines During Check-in:

1. Maintain social distancing of 6 feet between you and other people.
2. Sanitize hands.
3. Wear a face mask/covering.
4. Practice appropriate cough and sneeze etiquette. If tissue is used, dispose of tissue in an appropriate receptacle.
5. Health screening:
 1. Do you or anyone in your party have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of smell/taste, chills, muscle pain, nausea, diarrhea or sore throat? If yes, guests will not be allowed to camp and will be allowed to reschedule their camping date(s).
 2. Have you or anyone in your party had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 14-days? If yes, guests will not be allowed to camp and will be allowed to reschedule their camping date(s).
 3. Have you or someone that you have had close contact with been tested for COVID-19? Anyone in your party, to your knowledge? If yes, and results are not available yet, guests will not be allowed to camp and will be allowed to reschedule their camping date(s).

Guidelines While Camping:

1. Only 3 campsites are available at Halepa`o: Campsite 1, Campsite 3, and Campsite 5. Please remain in your designated campsite to maintain distancing between others camping at the other campsites.
2. Abide by the posted COVID-19 signs at the offices, restrooms, and showers.
3. Stagger use of shared spaces (such as the water, restrooms, showers) and maintain 6 feet of space between you and others in these areas.
4. Bring and wear a face mask/covering while using the restrooms and shower areas. Face masks/coverings must be worn while walking to and from these areas and may be removed only to shower.
5. Wash your hands/sanitize before and after using the restroom facility or touching commonly touched surfaces.
6. Do not touch your eyes, mouth, or nose with unwashed hands.
7. Practice proper cough and sneeze etiquette. If tissue is used, dispose of tissue in an appropriate trash receptacle.
8. Stay at least 6 feet away from others who do not live with you, both in and out of the water.
